- In addition to papers, what other research activities are our faculty involved in?





THE ORCID COMMUNITY



Researchers only need to register (free) and use their ORCID iD (free).

For there to be community value, researchers need to encounter systems that are collecting ORCID iDs and connecting information back to their record.

The CSUs should be those types of systems.

WHY JOIN AN ORCID CONSORTIUM?

You are joining a team, contributing to a community of practice, and benefiting from a group approach:

- Researcher engagement
- Vendor engagement
- Shared outreach and technical support across the consortium

AND consortia members qualify for reduced premium membership pricing

TIERS AND POLICIES

Membership fees are determined by consortium size:

- 5-9 members: US\$6,000 per member
- 10-19 members: US\$5,000 per member
- 20-34 members: US\$4,000 per member
- 35-60 members: US\$3,500 per member
- 61+ members: US\$3,000 per member

Each consortium is responsible for following the ORCID consortium policy for effective community management practices.

CONSORTIUM COMPARISON

Annual Premium Membership Fee, paid to ORCID	\$3,000 per member	\$4,000 per member	\$4,000* per member

• At 35 members, the rate will reduce to \$3,500 per member

WHAT CAN WE DO WITHOUT A MEMBERSHIP?

Campuses can use the Public API:

- Retrieve all ORCID iDs that claim to be associated with your campus
- Search public data
- Annual access to a public data file
- Set up an easy one-click way for researchers to create an ORCID iD
- Basically, we can read, but not write

WHAT CAN WE DO WITH A MEMBERSHIP?

Campuses would have access to the Premium Member API:

- Notified when changes happen to ORCID iDs held by your researchers
- Add/Update/Delete Works, Funding, Education and/or Employment to an ORCID iD (if granted permission by iD holder)
- Update/delete biographical data
- Monthly access to a public data file

WHAT CAN WE DO WITH A MEMBERSHIP?

Potential practical applications:

- Compile definitive list of publications and other research products produced by your campus researchers
- Automatically populate IRs with those publications (and their metadata!) soon after they are published
- Automatically populate faculty profiles with the Open-Access version of a paper found in the local IR
- Set up an easy one-click way for researchers to create an ORCID iD and/or automatically assert the campus's affiliation with the researcher
- Create automatic news feeds of the latest faculty publications
- Develope a searchable "Research Dashboard" describing grants and grant activities for each CSU campus and the whole CSU system (Fresca 2.0)

WHAT CAN WE DO WITH A MEMBERSHIP?

More potential practical applications:

- Compile expert lists for one CSU campus and the whole CSU system
- Make journal article submissions stronger by crowd-sourcing the curation of faculty profiles across campus units (Departments, Library, PR, Alumni)
- Giving public **credit to faculty for certifications** (e.g., IRB), trainings, or workshops they complete
- Adding acknowledgements of university service to faculty profiles
- Share data with Offices of Research and administrators involved in RPT processes (and their systems)




Already have an ORCID iD? Connect your existing ORCID iD

- The researcher is the only one who can register for an iD for her/himself or grant permissions for another system to read or update content on her record.
- An institution can both begin the registration process for the researcher and request his permission to access her record in a single workflow.
- This workflow can take place in an existing research information or profile system, or can even be emailed directly to faculty members

- The education affiliation is now asserted to the ORCID record.
- Only the SDSU client can edit this entry. The researcher may change the visibility or revoke the client's access.
