Lili Luo, researcher at San Jose State, is wrapping up the CSU Libraries Student Success Study and will report to COLD at the December 8, 2020 meeting. Jen has been working with Lili and library deans over the last two months to wrangle the last data submissions. Seventeen CSU Libraries were able to participate in the study. The committee will be reviewing the study results and areas for future analysis once the draft report is completed.

For the 2020-21 academic year, the committee will participate in the <a href="CSU Student Success">CSU Student Success</a> <a href="Analytics Certificate Program">Analytics Certificate Program</a>, a cohort program run out of the Chancellor's Office. Each team will select a project to work on together as we are guided through the program. This also helps to elevate the importance of student success to the CSU Libraries.
