





Primo Central

Primo Central – Keep in Mind

- Primo Central contains bib citation records (i.e. serves as index with URL's to the documents in the Primo "Details" tab), Alma delivers the full text of the documents. When you activate a resource in PCI, you are turning on that PCI resource's index.
- Primo Central uses an institutional holdings file from Alma Uresolver to determine what your subscription resources are (in other words, your PCI resources may be "Available" or "No full-text" depending on what coverage dates are authorized by Alma Electronic Collection Portfolio records).
- The source of the bib citation record (i.e. "Details" tab Source field) may not always be where you access full text (i.e. "View It" tab showing Alma resources).
- The resources in the PCI Activation Wizard may not directly reflect the collections you subscribe to.
- Bib citation records that show in the Primo Central results are ones you have full text access to. Use "Expand My Results" option for "No full-text".

Primo Central – Availability Using Institutional Holdings File

Primo Central Index resources which your institution has activated are compared by Primo to the Alma Institutional Holdings file built from the various Electronic Collection Portfolios which have been established, with subscription ranges, to determine if a given article from PCI is available.

EBSCO API – Keep in Mind

- Though Primo Central doesn't have EBSCO collections, it does contain many of the publications available through those collections.
- The metadata we receive from EBSCO is limited and cannot be enriched on our end.
- PCI and EBSCO results cannot be de-duplicated.
- Sorting is not available when EBSCO is configured in its own scope
- However, the default setup for the EBSCO API uses a separate search scope rather than blending the results with the other resources in the "Everything" search because:
 - A blended search scope which includes EBSCO API data would suppress all facet counts from the display, due to the way EBSCO data is supplied without frequency counts.
 - When searching facets, and using the "More Options" link to get the "Refine Search" light box, the "Exclude" option is unavailable.

Question:

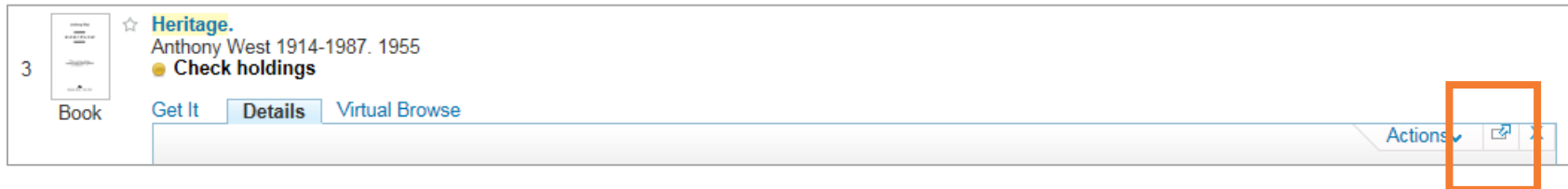
Trying to test the EBSCO API using known items that are loaded into the catalog or SFX. When searching just the EBSCO API in Primo, can't find the items. What are some search tips for the EBSCO API?

Answer:

- EBSCO built the API so EBSCO search logic applies rather than Primo.
- Tip 1: EBSCO interprets multiple words as a phrase while Primo inserts AND between terms.
 - Search: Shakespeare Hamlet becomes 'shakespearehamlet' in EBSCO reducing the likelihood of finding results.
- Tip 2: EBSCO uses single quote rather than double quote marks. Primo can use either.
- Tip 3: EBSCO and Primo can both use Boolean connectors AND, OR, NOT. These must be in all caps.
- Tip 4: Using Primo Advanced Search and training patrons to put single terms or phrases in each line will increase results in EBSCO API searches.
- Summary: Likelihood of success is increased by using Advanced Search or using single quotes for phrases and inserting UPPER CASE Boolean connectors (AND, OR, NOT) between search terms.
