

- Known item searching: <u>Curious George</u> | <u>Harry Potter</u>
- · Topical searches

### 2. Relevancy of results (plans)

- Ex Libris eager to analyze and assist
  - Need to thoroughly document problems
- Configuration changes
  - Relevance boosting settings
  - Newspaper search
- · Address any indexing issues
- Best practices for Primo Central collection activation

- Currently optimized for more complex use cases
- · Expects user to login
- Default labels are jargon-y
- e.g., Harry Potter prisoner

## 3. & 4. Availability & Requests (plans)


- Exhaust configuration options


### 5. UX issues
